1 CONTROLLED LIST STANDARD

1.1 Introduction

1.1.1 Application

This document contains the formatting and values for the ISB Controlled List Standard **Address Line Type**.

This Controlled List is referred to by the **Address_Line_Type** attribute of the **Address Line** entity, which is defined within the **Locator** Business Data Standard.

This Controlled List is considered to be architectural.

1.1.2 Compatibility with non-ISB standards

There are no known compatibility issues related to this standard.

2 CONTROLLED LIST DESCRIPTION

The following table contains the definition of the name of the controlled list together with a description that explains what it is about. It also contains the definition of the Data Type and Format of the values.

Controlled List Name: Address Line Type	
Description	A controlled list of values that identifies the type of ADDRESS LINE e.g. Property Name, Address Line 1, County, Post Code, Zip Code etc.
Data Type and Format	Unicode_String(1,50)

Double Dependent Locality	A locality used to distinguish between similar thoroughfare names within a dependent locality.	AddressBase, PAF

Area	Highest level local administrative area.	AddressBase, BS7666
Post Town	Town or city within which Royal Mail sorting office is located for that address.	AddressBase, PAF, BS7666
Town	Town name.	AddressBase, PAF, BS7666
County	County name.	Legacy item for postal addresses
PO Box	PO Box number.	PAF
