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1 CONTROLLED LIST STANDARD

1.1 Introduction

1.1.1 Application

This document contains the formatting and values for the ISB Controlled List Standard **Moderation Type**.

Moderation_Type attribute of the **Assessable** subtype of the **Qualification Element** entity, which is defined within the **Qualification Element** Business Data Standard.

This Controlled List defines the method to be used for moderation of Qualification Element.

This Controlled List is considered to be one that a User might pick a value from, for example "Online" or "Visiting" may be provided as options on a screen.

1.1.2 Compatibility with non-ISB standards

The following table contains the definition of the name of the controlled list together with a description that explains what it is about. It also contains the definition of the Data Type and Format of the values.

Controlled List Name: Moderation Type	
Description	A controlled list of values that indicates the method to be used for moderation of this QUALIFICATION ELEMENT. E.g. "Postal", "Online", "Visiting", "Residential", "Mixed".
Data Type and Format	Unicode_String(1,32)

3 CONTROLLED LIST

The following table contains the list of permissible values for the attribute together with a short description and the source of the value, where relevant.

Value	Description	Source
Postal	Indicates the learner's work is submitted through a postal service for the assessor to moderate the work.	JCQ DSG
Online	Indicates the learner's work is submitted through an online submission service for the assessor to moderate the work.	JCQ DSG
Visiting	Indicates learner's work is moderated by an assessor during a centre visit.	JCQ DSG
Residential	Indicates learner's work is moderated by an assessor at a residential event.	JCQ DSG
Mixed	Indicates a combination of two or more moderation methods is applicable for the learner's work.	JCQ DSG
