1 Introduction

1.1 Document Purpose

This document contains the formatting and values for an ISB Controlled List standard. This Controlled List is referenced in one or many approved ISB Business Data Standards.

1.2 Document Status

“Approved” means the standard is approved by the ISB. Approved standards are initially given “Recommended” status, where trials are encouraged. After implementation experience (and possible refinement in the light of experience) they are approved with “Adopted” status where adoption is strongly advocated.

1.3 Business Context

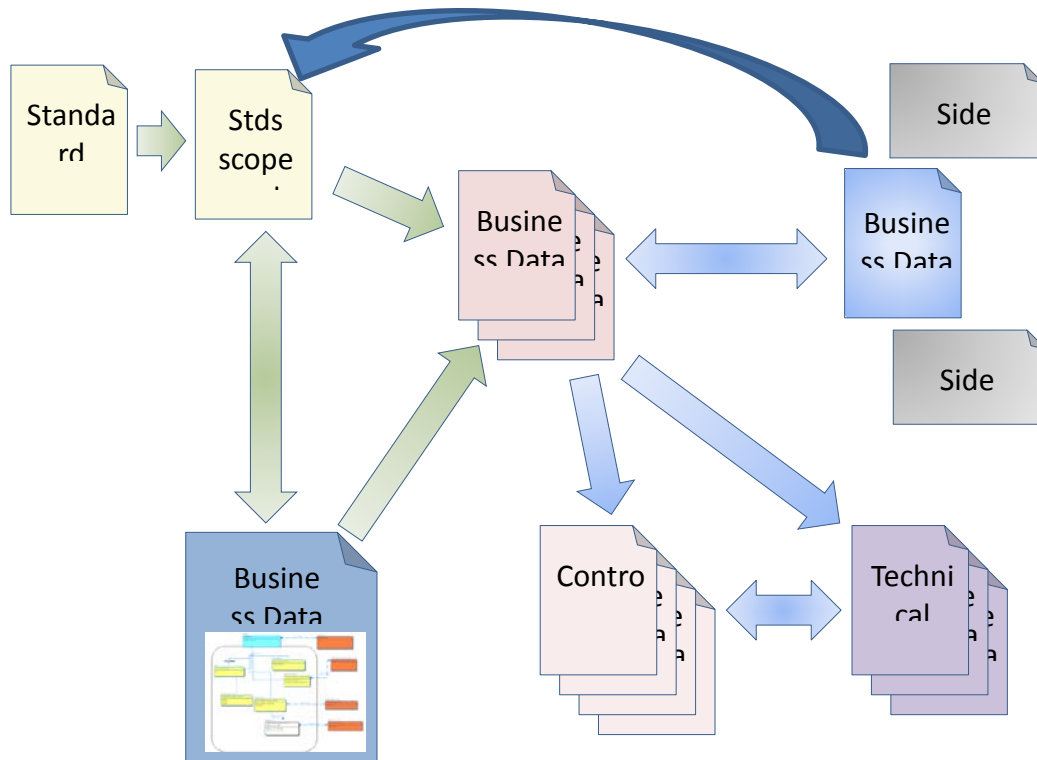
A Business Data Standard is defined in response to a business need captured in a Standards Development Request and approved by the ISB.

ISB BDSs standardise a part of the Business Data Architecture component of an Enterprise Architecture. The architecture as a whole is a stand-alone document, see ISB, *Business Data Architecture*, (ISB Website), those parts that are approved by the ISB are contained in the set of approved BDSs. Only by alignment to an architecture can the BDSs be made modular yet fit together in ways appropriate to the overall business of ESCS.

In development, every effort is made to ensure that the Business Data Standard is capable of supporting all ESCS business needs for the same data. The Standards Development Request and subsequent analysis may give rise to a number of Business Data Standards, and the way that the standards meet the originating business need is shown via an “Assembly” document. Each Assembly may in addition need some guidance regarding data quality and implementation issues and these are contained in Side Notes. Where a value is constrained to a specific set of values, a Controlled List Standard will be created defining those values. A Controlled List Standard may be used by several Business Data Standards.

1.4 How to use this Controlled List

Controlled Lists represent the possible values of a constrained attribute for data interchange. Systems compliant with ISB data standards may store a subset of values and may internally represent those values in any way seen fit, as long as they can be converted to the values specified for interchange. This Controlled List is referred to by the:

Org_Post_Fulfilment_Status_Type attribute of the **Organisation Post Fulfilment** entity, which is defined within the **Organisation Post Fulfilment Business Data Standard**.
