## 1.1 Introduction

### 1.1.1 Application

This document contains the formatting and values for the ISB Controlled List Standard **Personal Group Type**.

This Controlled List is referred to by the **Personal\_Group\_Type** attribute of the **Personal Group** entity, which is defined within the **Personal Group** Business Data Standard.

The Controlled List defines the Personal Group category that a party may belong to.

This Controlled List is considered to be one that a User might pick a value from, for example, "Household" or "Gang" may be provided as options on a screen.

The following table contains the list of permissible values for the attribute together with a short description and the source of the value, where relevant.

Value	Description	Source
Circle of Support	A group of family, friends and supportive workers who come together to give support and friendship to a person.	Barnardos; Borough of Southwark; Borough of Sutton; East Sussex
Household	A group of individuals that are typically domiciled at the same address.	Barnardos; Borough of Southwark; Borough of Sutton; East Sussex
Extended Family	A family which extends beyond the nuclear family to include grandparents and other relatives.	Barnardos; Borough of Southwark; Borough of Sutton; East Sussex
Gang	A group of adolescents who band together, especially a group of delinquents.	Barnardos; Borough of Southwark; Borough of Sutton; East Sussex
Training Group	A group of individuals within a training programme.	Barnardos; Borough of Southwark; Borough of Sutton; East Sussex
