This Controlled List is referred to by the **Personal\_Rel\_Basis\_Type** attribute of the **PR Personal Relationship** entity, which is defined within the **PR Personal Relationship** Business Data Standard.

A controlled list defining the relationship basis between two parties.

This Controlled List is considered to be one that a User might pick a value from, for example, "Legal" or "Biological" may be provided as options on a screen.

<b>Description</b>	A controlled list defining the relationship basis of Party_1st and Party_2nd within a Personal Relationship. Values include "Biological", "Legal", "Friendship", "Life-Partnership".
<b>Data Type and Format</b>	Unicode_String(1,30)

The following table contains the list of permissible values for the attribute together with a short description and the source of the value, where relevant.

Value	Description	Source
Biological	The relationship basis between two Parties is genetic, related by blood.	Children's Services Analysis
Cohabiting	A living arrangement in which an unmarried couple lives together in a long-term relationship that resembles a marriage.	Children's Services Analysis
Friendship	The relationship is due to close association and mutual trust between two parties.	Children's Services Analysis
Informal Care	The relationship basis is due to the provision of care from one party to another. There is no legal obligation for the provision of this care.	Children's Services Analysis
Legal	The relationship basis between two parties is of a legal nature.	Children's Services Analysis
Life-Partnership	The relationship basis between two parties is due to marriage or civil partnership.	Children's Services Analysis
