1.1 Introduction

1.1.1 Application

This document contains the formatting and values for the ISB Controlled List Standard **Personal Relationship Influence Type**.

This Controlled List is referred to by the **Pers_Rel_Influence_Type** attribute of the **PR Personal Rel Influence** entity, which is defined within the **PR Personal Relationship Influence** Business Data Standard.

The Controlled List describes the type of influence a Party may have over another Party.

This Controlled List is considered to be one that a User might pick a value from, for example, "Positive" or "Negative" may be provided as options on a screen.

Value	Description	Source
Positive	Party 1 st has a positive influence upon Party 2 nd .	Children's Analysis
