# 1 CONTROLLED LIST STANDARD

## 1.1 Introduction

### 1.1.1 Application

This document contains the formatting and values for the ISB Controlled List Standard **Personal Relationship Role Name Type**.

This Controlled List is referred to by the **Party\_1st\_Pers\_Role\_Name\_Type** and the **Party\_2nd\_Pers\_Role\_Name\_Type** attributes of the **PR Personal Relationship** entity, which is defined within the **PR Personal Relationship Business Data Standard**.

The Controlled List describes the name of each Party within that Personal Relationship.

This Controlled List is considered to be one that a User might pick a value from, for example, "Mother" or "Brother" may be provided as options on a screen.
